

## SP500 FUNDERS RISK DISCLOSURE POLICY

**SP500 Funders DMCA Policy** applies to the website <a href="www.sp500f.com">www.sp500f.com</a> and its related services, outlining how copyright infringement notices are handled.

**Intellectual Property Protection:** SP500 Funders values intellectual property protection and responds swiftly to clear copyright infringement notices under the Digital Millennium Copyright Act (DMCA) of 1998. Users should ensure their claims are accurate to avoid potential liability for damages and legal costs.

**Filing Infringement Notices:** To file an infringement notice, you must provide:

- Identification of the copyrighted work and the infringing material.
- Contact information.
- Statements of good faith regarding the infringement and authorization to act on behalf of the rights owner.
- Physical or electronic signature.

Notices must meet DMCA requirements. If materials are removed in response to a notice, a copy of the notice may be provided to the affected user, who can then file a counter-notice.

Counter-Notices: Users whose material has been removed can file a counter-notice by providing:

- Identification of the removed material and its previous location.
- Contact information.
- Statements of good faith regarding the removal error.
- Consent to jurisdiction and service of process.
- Physical or electronic signature.
- SP500 Funders reserves the right not to act if the counter-notice does not meet requirements.
